Kyle Rowter and Pierre Martel of the Mersey Tobeatic Research Institute in Kempt have been recording the hourly temperature of deep local lakes for the last two years. They are conducting a long term monitoring study in co-operation with Acadia University and Parks Canada to learn about climate change and the deep cold water habitat which is important for wildlife like brook trout. The two researchers are encouraging people who live near water to participate in their "IceWatch" program by recording the dates when lakes or rivers freeze and thaw and contacting them at 682-2371.
