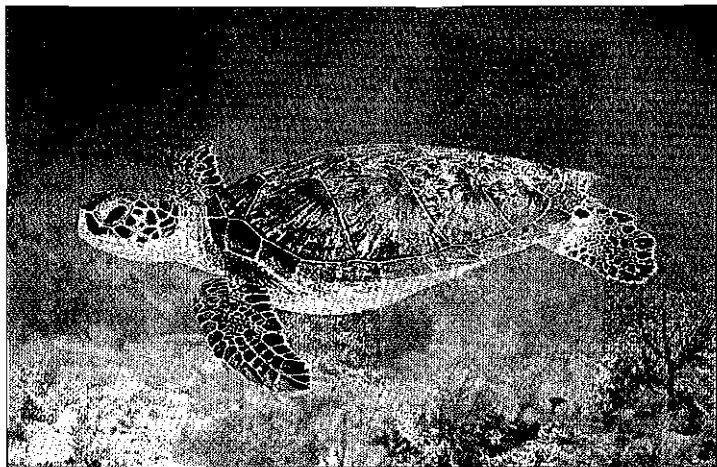
Mersey Tobeatic Research Institute hosts turtle day
